

Criteria for the Raymore Chamber of Commerce 2010 Scholarship Application

1. Applicant must currently be a senior at Raymore-Peculiar High School.
2. Applicant must have received no more than 4 disciplinary actions while in high school (e.g., detentions, ISS, OSS, etc.).
3. Applicant must submit the completed and signed scholarship application to the RPHS Counselor's Office no later than March 31, 2010.
4. All information must be typed (*no handwritten applications will be accepted*) and all additional sheets must be stapled to the application form.
5. Applicant should not put his/her name or any personal identifying information on the additional sheets. Each application will be assigned a number, which will be placed on the cover sheet and on each additional sheet of the application. The cover sheet will then be removed before the applications are submitted to the panel of judges, so the judges will not know the identity of any of the applicants until after the judging has been completed.
6. All statements and essays must be composed by the applicant and submitted in typewritten format.

Information about the Raymore Chamber of Commerce 2010 Scholarship Application

1. The Chamber will award one (1) or more \$1,000 scholarships. [In 2009, the Raymore Chamber awarded two (2) \$1,500 scholarships and one (1) \$1,000 scholarship.]
2. Applications will be judged by a panel of Chamber members. Names of the applicants will not be available to the panel members until after the judging has been completed.
3. Scholarship recipients and their parents/guardians will be invited to attend a Chamber meeting where the recipients will be recognized and presented with certificates/checks.
4. The scholarship will be paid when the recipient provides the Chamber with written confirmation that he/she has been accepted and enrolled at a specific college or technical school (Examples of written confirmation: letter from college or school confirming enrollment, copy of bill for tuition, book fees, etc.).
5. Scholarships are for one year only.
